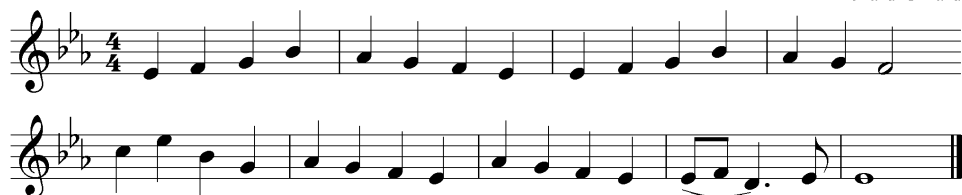


Richard Gillard

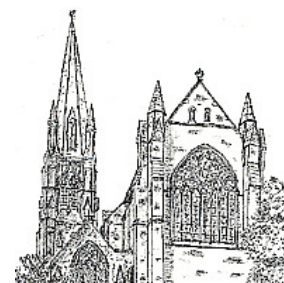
